- Students must follow the aadaab of the Masjid and instruction of the teachers/staff. There is zero tolerance for violent behavior. Those who continually disrupt class or disrespect the Masjid and/or their fellow students will be subject to disciplinary action, including expulsion.
- Students should wear proper Islamic attire to the masjid, such as salwar kameez or thobe and topi for boys and hijab and abaya for girls. No shorts, clothing with images or inappropriate language or tight fitting clothing is permitted. Girls should refrain from wearing jewelry, nail polish or perfume.
- Parents are responsible for their student being on-time for the start class and being picked up promptly at the conclusion of class. Lateness is disruptive to students and may result in disciplinary action. MNI will not provide supervision before or after classes and parents/guardians are responsible for their student outside of class times.
- Students are required to be present and focused during class. Any cell phone, games or any other sources of distraction may be confiscated by teachers and returned to the student's parent at the end of class. Students found lingering outside the classroom area during class time will be subject to disciplinary action.
- Parents/Guardians are required to attend parent/teacher meetings and respond to report cards and other school correspondence.
- Additionally, parents are strongly encouraged to assist their students with homework and reviewing their lessons. Parents should encourage students to implement what they have learned and strive to create a supportive environment at home.
